St Bernard of Clairvaux

St. Bernard, Abbot and Doctor of the Church St. Bernard was born of noble parentage in Burgundy, France, in the castle of Fontaines near Dijon in 1090.. Under the care of his pious parents he was sent at an early age to a college at Chatillon, where he was conspicuous for his remarkable piety and spirit of recollection. At the same place he entered upon the studies of theology and Holy Scripture. After the death of his mother, fearing the snares and temptations of the world, he resolved to embrace the newly established and very austere institute of the Cistercian Order.

In 1113, St. Bernard, with thirty young noblemen, presented himself to the holy Abbot, St. Stephen, at Citeaux. After a novitiate spent in great fervor, he made his profession in the following year. His superior soon after, seeing the great progress he had made in the spiritual life, sent him with twelve monks to found a new monastery. St. Bernard was at once appointed Abbot and began that active life which has rendered him the most conspicuous figure in the history of the 12th century. He founded numerous other monasteries, wrote several books and undertook many journeys for the honor of God. The reputation of St. Bernard spread far and wide; even the Popes were governed by his advice.

Bernard emphasized the importance of lectio divina and contemplation for monks. The abbot had observed that when lectio divina was neglected, monasticism suffered.

Bernard's theology and Mariology continue to be of major importance. Bernard helped found 163 monasteries in different parts of Europe. His influence led Alexander III to launch reforms. He was canonized by Alexander III 18 January 1174. Cistercians honour him as one of the greatest early Cistercians.

His feast day is 20 August 1153.

Bernard is Dante Alighieri's last guide, in Divine Comedy, as he travels through the Empyrean. Dante's narrative use of Bernard suggests that the saint was famous at the time for profound mysticism, his devotion to Mary, and his reputation for eloquence.
